Anthony*** with a community conversation to follow. A pre-show happy hour at 4:30pm offers opportunities for conversation and includes a voter registration drive. This all-ages, educational and entertaining event is one night only on Sat. March 14, 2026 at **Q-Staff Theatre** located at 400 Broadway Blvd SE, ABQ, NM 87102 at the corner of Lead and Broadway.

Susan B. Anthony (1820-1906) was a dynamic and eloquent leader of the women’s rights movement. Though she did not live to see the passage of the Nineteenth Amendment in 1920, it was largely through her unflinching efforts that women gained the right to vote. Guest Artist **Rose Stephenson** brings to life this great leader through her speeches, journal entries, and letters. ***Failure is Impossible*** will cover the

events of Anthony's life from her childhood to her death in 1906, as well as her lifelong collaboration and friendship with Elizabeth Cady Stanton and other influential women's rights activists.

Immediately following the performance, the League of Women Voters Central NM and guest artist Rose Stephenson will answer questions and lead a community conversation about the history of women's suffrage and current voting rights issues. Volunteers will be on hand to help register voters.
